Justus

Colossians 4:11 (He has been a comfort to me) Epaphras fervently prayed, Colossians 4:12

V. Necessary

Aristarchus

Colossians 4:10, Acts 19:29, Acts 27 (always with Paul in hard times)
He was a friend at all times, Proverbs 17:17. Not like Demas, 2 Timothy 4:10

VI. Dedicated

Jesus

Romans 5:8, 2 Corinthians 5:21, Revelation 1:8
