The Directions for Modesty, 1 Peter 3:1-6

- A. Modesty shies away from extravagance, v. 3
Not sin to be pretty, beauty not in clothing, Pr. 31:30
- B. Modesty highlights character, v. 4
Most beautiful attribute is invisible, heart, is it pure?
- C. Modesty is an imperishable quality, v. 4
Clothing gets dated, worn, the heart remains, 2 Cor. 4:16
- D. Modesty is precious in God's sight
Precious (Mk 14:3, 1 Tm 2:19), father/daughter
Attract the right kind of person, not the wrong kind
- E. Modesty's Heritage, v. 5-6
Beautiful women known by their works, 1 Tm 2:10
What characterized these women? Unattached to world,
holy
- F. Modesty has evangelistic power, v. 1-2
