Externally

“My adversaries taunt me all the day long,” v. 3

Turmoil is within us, v. 5

My soul is cast down within me, v. 6

Why are you cast down? V. 11

## **III. But Then We Remember**

I remember the joy of worship, v. 4

I remember the joy of creation, v. 6-7

I remember the joy of love, v. 8

So Pants My Soul For You, O God.  
My soul thirsts for God, for the living God.  
When shall I come and appear before God?*
