- B. Our world follows that as well

- C. Jesus came to give a standard
Something beyond us, and this world
- D. Jesus' believed enough to die
Either it is true or not true, 1 Cor 15:19

II. Power of Truth, John 8:37b

- A. Power to Liberate, John 8:32 Truth set you free
Free from death, sin, hopelessness
- B. Power to Separate, John 17:17 Sanctify/cleanse
You can be different, you can grow
- C. Power to Animate, John 4:24
How to worship, live and look to future

III. Personality of Truth, John 18:38

- A. Scripture is Truth, John 17:17
2 Timothy 3:16-17, John 15:26-27, Psalm 119:89
- B. Savior is Truth, John 14:6
John 1:14, 17, Acts 4:12, 1 John 5:12
